Report from Parish Pastoral Council Chair (Derek Evans):

We cancelled the meeting scheduled for Monday 23 January because we had too many away and we have found our numbers have dwindled. I would like parishioners to reconsider their stewardship role in 2017 and see if there is room in your busy life to become a Parish Pastoral Council member.

There have been a number of changes in the clergy appointments across the Archdiocese and we remain in the position of having a resident priest.

On the PPC agenda, we have developed a rolling parish calendar (items will be included in the 'save the date' or parish happenings in the newsletters); we are going to start up the Brunch BBQs again—although we need some volunteers to do this in Kilcoy; the sacramental program is in full swing in February and March; the Parish Fest to be held in Kilcoy (needs some volunteers) and we have working bees scheduled in both churches prior to Easter.

During January, we have been through old records and books and found that the history of the parish is very rich (as most would know) ... to that

The Archdiocese conducted the internal child safety and vulnerable adults audit late last year and we have to review a number of items to make sure that we continue to comply with the policy in 2017 and beyond ... the report is a work-in-progress and as we need to do refreshers etc, you will be notified.

PFC met on Monday 30 January with the view to finalising the 2016 accounts for the audit and the parishioners update. These 2 activities are well on the way with the proposed presentation dates for the update on Sunday 25 February at Woodford and Sunday 5 March at Kilcoy—a brochure is being collated as has been our practice in the last few years and copies will be available at both churches.

As with the PPC, 2017 is looking to be challenging from a financial perspective but there are lots of great activities that we can link with the wider community.
