New processes: for Blue Cards & Police Checks
These are now centralised because the distributing authorities were getting confused in dealing with so many parishes. The forms are now 'pre-generated' and pre-filled and available in the office so when you need a Blue Card or Police Check renewed, ask Julie-Anne for the form to complete. You need points for identification and these need to be cop-ied and submitted with the application—they can be copied at the office.
