Last week, a Workplace Health and Safety audit was conducted for the Parish (in both Woodford and Kilcoy). The outcomes will be finalised over the next few weeks but a couple of new things need to be introduced to protect our parishioners and visitors.

**SAFETY TIP:** Whenever you are using a ladder (of any description), please make sure that there is someone else around. If the ladder is over 1.8 meters, there needs to be an anchor person holding the ladder for the person climbing the ladder.

**4 Ladder Safety Tips**

- 1 Place ladder on a **STABLE SURFACE**
- 2 Avoid **ELECTRICAL HAZARDS**
- 3 Set up in a **4:1 RATIO**
- 4 Use **3 POINTS OF CONTACT**
